Authorization to Solicit Bids Re: 25 Location Utility Project

Stanchina conveyed that the 25 Location utility project is ready to be bid and that if the solicitation of bids were approved at the current meeting, the bid opening could take place at the August 20, 2012, City Council meeting. He noted that the projected cost of the project will be approximately \$340,000. Rosen supported the idea of obtaining bids with both a fall and spring price. The City Council concluded that it would be optimal to allow 60 days for completion of the project.

It was moved by Moraska and supported by Farragh to authorize the solicitation of bids for the 25 Location utility project.

Review and Approval of Chapin Pit Pavilion Design

Stanchina clarified that the proposed pavilion will not be lit. Alessandrini suggested that solar panels be employed prior to the City taking ownership of improvements when illumination is required.
