

Adult Use Marijuana Facility Application Scoring Rubric

The city's goal is to issue licenses to the applicants who are best suited to operate in compliance with MCL 333.27959 in the city. The scoring rubric is being used to assist the city in deciding among competing applications, the applicants best suited for a license based on a competitive process. The city will score the applications to the best of its ability and utilize the scoring criteria as a guide to provide a basis as why an applicant was selected for licensing.

Scoring category	Available points
Current medical marihuana facility license status and number of licenses in the City; prequalification in the State of Michigan.	Ten (10) points
Background of the applicant, including past ownership interest in a business or businesses operating in the State of Michigan; past compliance with business licensing requirements, including marijuana business licenses issued by LARA; and residency in the City or Dickinson County for at least two years.	Ten (10) points
Human resources, including number of full-time equivalent employees, proposed staffing plan, benefits package, complete with descriptions of duties/qualification/hiring criteria and proposed wage for each position (each must exceed 200% of federal poverty). Documented employee policy book and code of ethics to ensure honesty and integrity of employees.	Fifteen (15) points
Physical investment, including the applicant's detailed proposed tangible capital investment; the current and proposed condition of the proposed location; and the applicant's ownership stake in the physical location of the establishment.	Twenty (20) points
Area impact, detailed and demonstrated exterior improvements, specific property improvements through elimination of blight and maintenance plan that provides for upkeep of property, including exterior and right-of-way.	Ten (10) points
Applicant proposes locating multiple licenses, Grower, Processor or/and Retail, within the City of Iron Mountain.	Ten (10) points
Security plan, deter and prevent unauthorized entrance into the facility with alerts to owner and police, prevent theft and diversion, secure storage of marijuana and proceeds, details for recordkeeping and inventory management, msds sheets for hazardous materials or sworn attestation that none will be present.	Ten (10) points
