City Manager Marquart presented the following during his City Manager Report:

1. The City has received requests to sell City property by Lakeside Dr. and Lake Antoine. The City will table any consideration for sale until further studies can be conducted for utilization of the property
2. Latest sampling of Crystal Lake water shows the areas tested at below normal levels except near the old pipe which tested above normal. Further testing will be conducted.
